We have worked hard to make positive changes at the Library and thank everyone who supported us throughout the year.

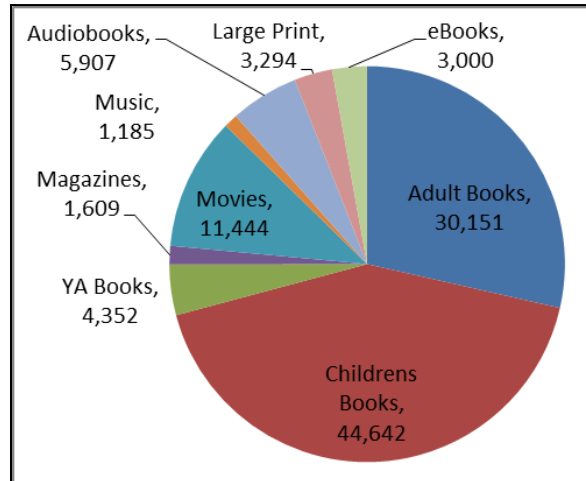
