Note that dues have been increased slightly to \$15, but did you know that the average cost of a museum pass is \$106? A bargain.

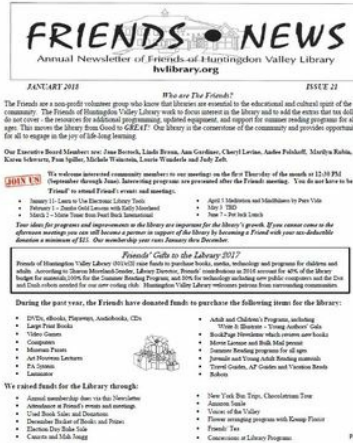
