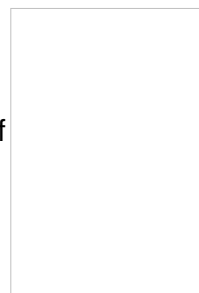

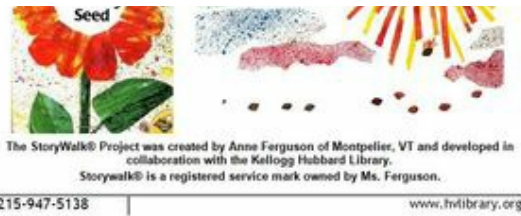

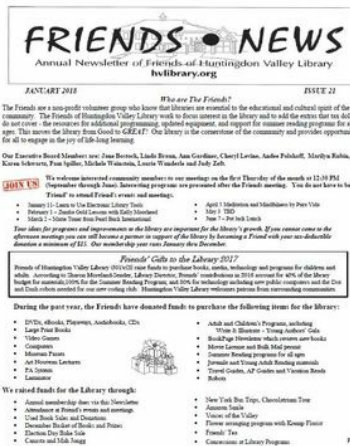
Thank you for renewing your Membership to the Friends of Huntingdon Valley Library.
