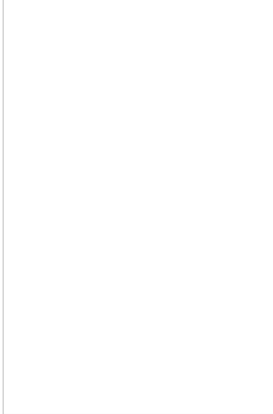

PlayAways are self-contained, mp3 audiobooks that children can hang around their neck and listen to in the car, on the sofa, or while cleaning their room. ;-)

We have adult titles with the adult audiobooks, too. They check out for 3 weeks.



PlayAway Views are picture book sets that have been brought to life with sound and motion. Shown above: Mo Willem's *Don't Let Pigeon Drive the Bus*. These check out for 1 week, like a DVD.

Used Book Sales. The Friends book room opens its doors to the public multiple times each year. In 2017, we have sales in the Spring, Summer and Fall.

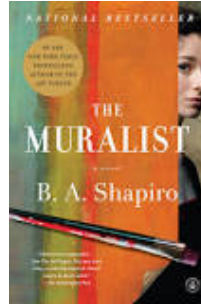
