



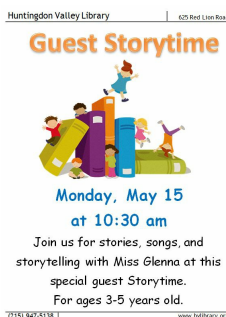



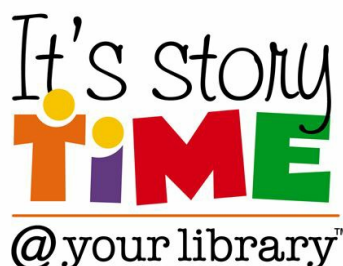

- Perpetual Sale at the Library's front entrance with Book Bundles and books for all ages

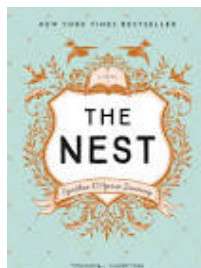
