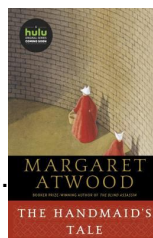

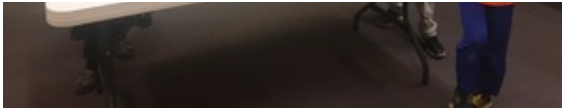
## Director's Corner
