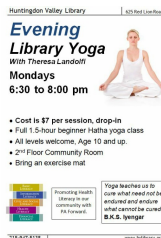

- **Novice Computer Users** - 7 to 8 pm. Join CESOP for a Novice Computer Users group. Free and Open to all.



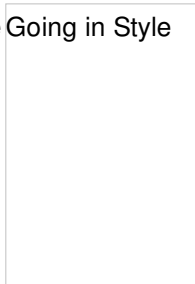
Thursday, September 28
