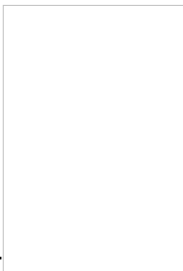

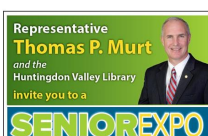

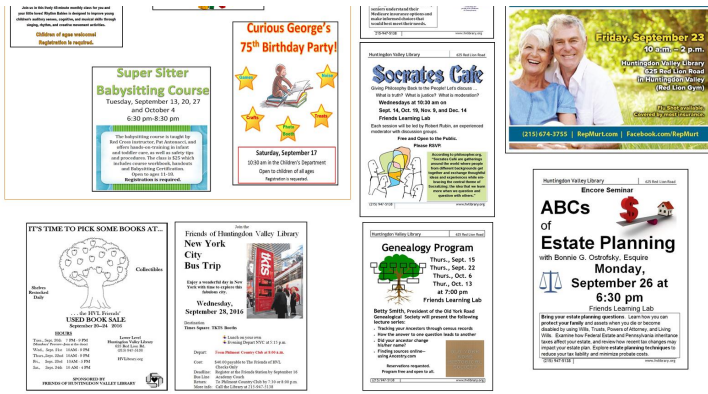

Director's Corner:

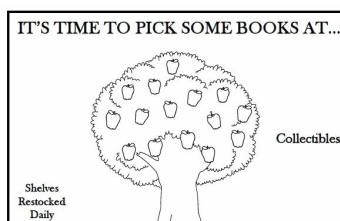

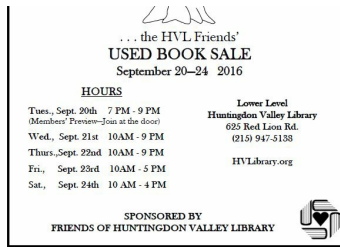
