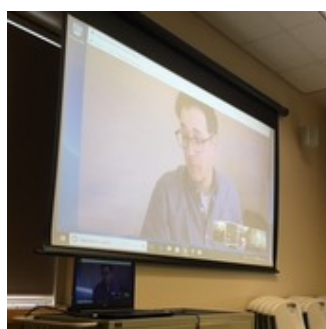

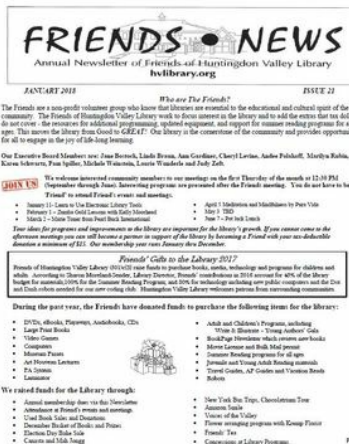
Thank you for renewing your Membership to the Friends of Huntington Valley Library.
