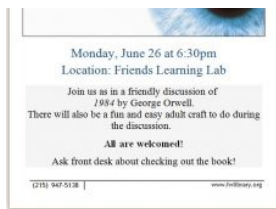

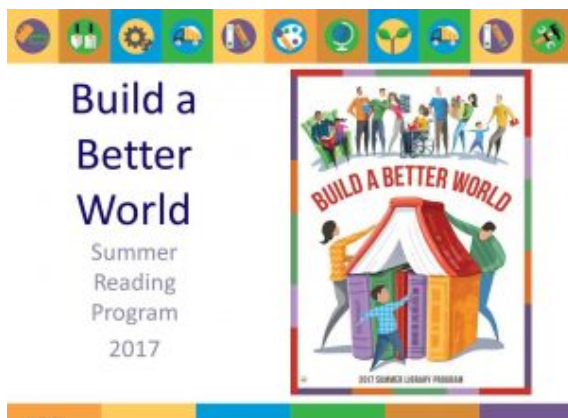

Director's Corner

Summer Reading starts this week! Get ready for children reading quietly on bean bags and couches, teens meeting authors and exploring new ideas and skills, and families enjoying great programs and events throughout the summer. **We invite you to stop by anytime after 10 am on Monday, June 26** to sign-up and pick up a bag o' goodies for each child or teen who registers...then start reading (or listening).



Why do we obsess about **Summer Reading**? What's the big deal?

Summer Reading Club is about much more than fun. Reading over the summer is incredibly important for students and their **academic achievement**. Here's why:

- Children who don't read over the summer experience **summer learning loss**. Children don't just feel like they've forgotten some of what they've learned -- they actually do forget it...and the effect is cumulative. Children who lose reading skills over the summer will be two years behind their classmates by the end of 6th grade. By joining the Summer Reading Club and attending free library programs, kids can prevent this from happening.
- The Summer Reading Club encourages children to **read for enjoyment**. They can read whatever they want, which helps instill a love of reading for recreation. Studies show that kids who read for fun often out-perform kids who don't in school.
- The Summer Reading Club and all of its activities are absolutely free, offering everyone **safe, educational opportunities throughout the summer**.
