Tony Webster (Broadbent) leads a reclusive and quiet existence until long buried secrets from his past force him to face the flawed recollections of his younger self, the truth about his first love (Rampling) and the devastating consequences of decisions made a lifetime ago. Rating: PG-13 (for thematic elements, a violent image, sexuality and brief strong language.) Runtime: 108 minutes

Dec. 8 Certain Women

The lives of three women intersect in small-town America, where each is imperfectly blazing a trail. Based on stories by Maile Meloy. Rating: R (for some language) Runtime: 107 minutes.

Dec. 15 The Midwife (Sage Femme)

Two of French cinema's biggest stars shine in this bittersweet drama about the unlikely friendship that develops between Claire (Catherine Frot), a talented but tightly wound midwife, and Béatrice (Catherine Deneuve), the estranged, free-spirited mistress of Claire's late father. Rating: NR. Runtime: 117 minutes.

Dec. 22 My Cousin Rachel

A young Englishman plots revenge against his late cousin's mysterious beautiful wife believing her responsible for his death. But his feelings become complicated as he finds himself falling under her spell of her charms. Rating: PG-13 (for some sexuality and brief strong language) Runtime: 106 minutes.

Dec. 29 Kedi

A profile of an ancient city and its "unique" people, seen through the eyes of the most mysterious and beloved animal humans have ever known "The Cat." NR. Runtime: 79 minutes.

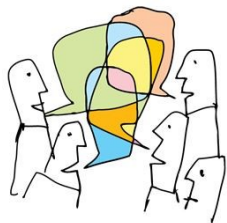

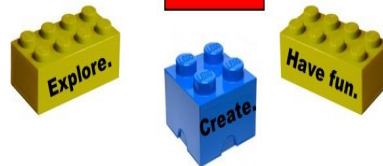
