Young Adult Book Club

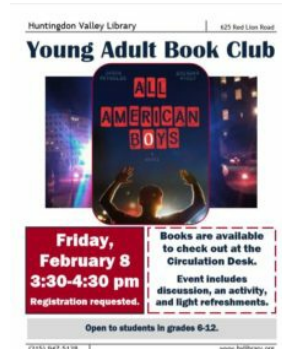
Join us after school for the next Young Adult Book Club! We will discuss **contemporary novel** *All American Boys* by Jason Reynolds and Brendan Kiely.

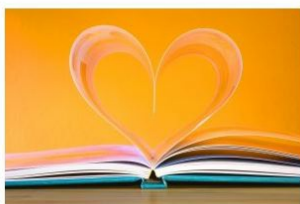
