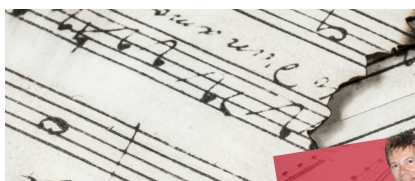

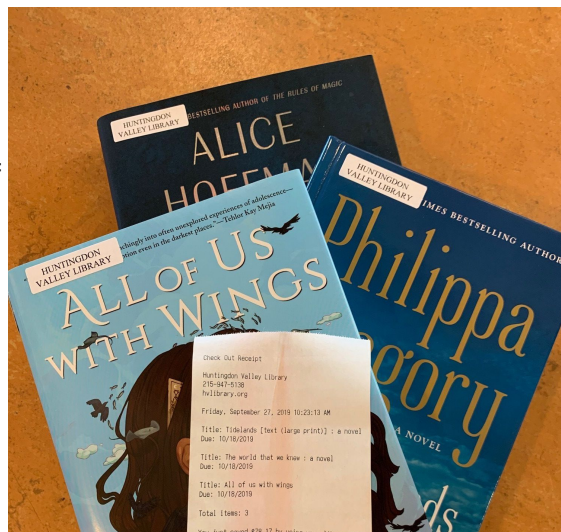

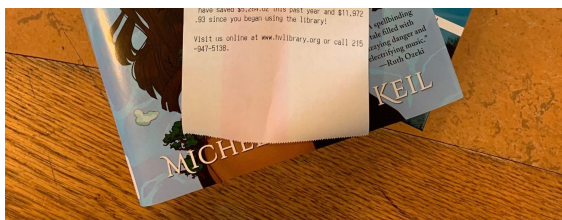
### An AMAZING Value!
