robotics, and new lecture and film series that I feel 2018 is being left behind! As I shared with the Board at last night's meeting, we ended 2018 with a 20% increase in program attendance, a 1% increase in circulation, and over 2,200 volunteer hours compared to 1,900 last year. Yep, I celebrate a 1% increase in circulation as many libraries are seeing steep declines. Use of movies has really diminished and I blame smart TVs! I just learned how to connect to my Amazon Prime account at home and can now stream even more content. The times change and the Library learns to adapt.


