Director's Corner

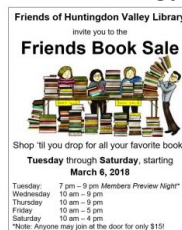

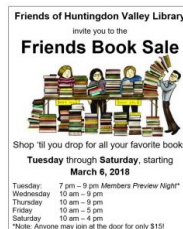
