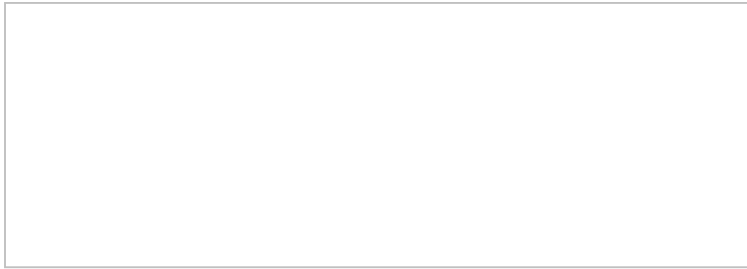

The **Friends of Huntingdon Valley** invite you to see **Moulin Rouge** on Broadway!

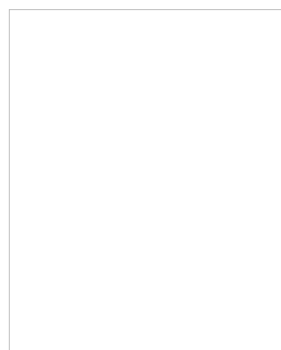

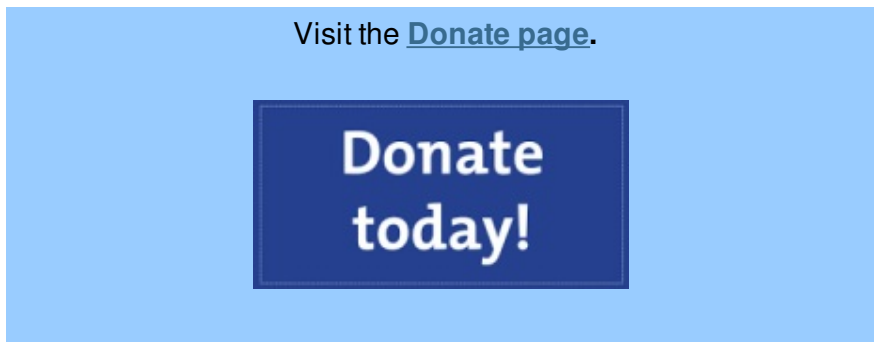
