Director's Corner

Community Design Collaborative

On March 14, we had our first [Community Design Collaborative](#) Task Force meeting with the team of volunteer architects from [Lenhardt Rodgers Architecture + Interiors](#).

First, I want to **THANK** everyone who volunteered their time to participate - we had a group of 24 including the full Board, a few

participate - we had a group of 24 including the full Board, a few Friends, folks from the Township, community members, patrons, students, volunteers, and staff. Joyce Lendhardt and her team lead us through a review of our existing building, a bit of visioning, and then let us review images and ideas from other libraries before playing with layout options and floor plans! We will meet again in a month or two to review and critique some **preliminary conceptual design** options. While the final project is limited to a conceptual design, this will help tremendously with the next step: fundraising for a Capital Campaign.

The Library was awarded *pro bono* preliminary design services in a competitive process. "Design Grants typically provide between \$15,000 and \$35,000 in preliminary design services - donated by highly skilled volunteers with expertise in architecture, landscape architecture, engineering, cost estimating, historic preservation, interior design, urban design, city planning, lighting design, graphic design, and more."



We are so excited and grateful to have been awarded a Design Grant and are thoroughly enjoying this process. It's fun to dream big...


