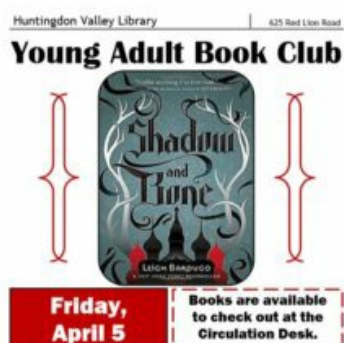
- **Tai Chi Class** - 11 am. With Michael McCormack, \$7, Drop in.

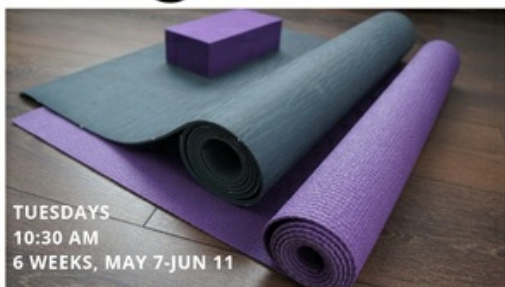

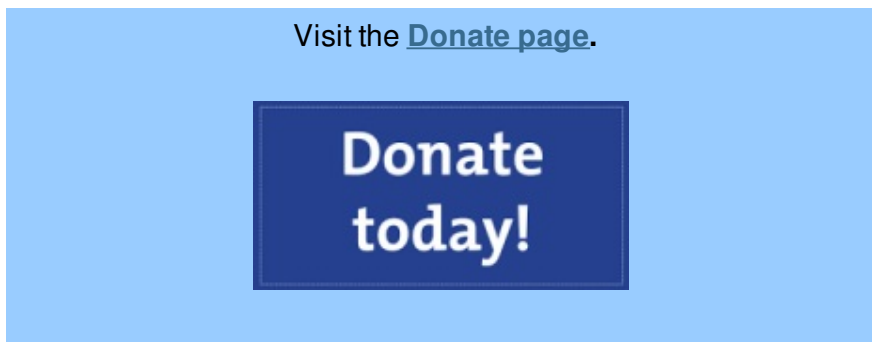
