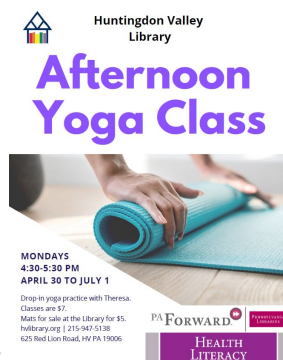

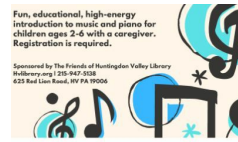
Tuesday, May 7

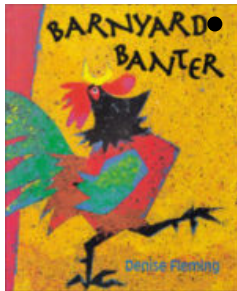

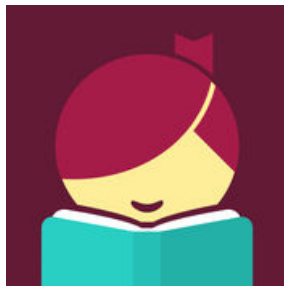

- Almost 60 years ago, collector and horticulturist Henry Francis du Pont (1869–1959) opened his childhood home, Winterthur, to the public. Today, Winterthur (pronounced “win-ter-tur”) is the premier museum of American decorative arts, with an unparalleled collection of nearly 90,000 objects made or used in America between about 1640 and 1860. The collection is displayed in the magnificent 175-room house, much as it was when the du Pont family lived here, as well as in gardens and changing exhibition galleries.
- Winterthur is set amidst a 1,000-acre preserve of rolling meadows and woodlands. Designed by du Pont, its 60-acre renaissance garden is among America’s best, with magnificent specimen plantings and massed displays of color.
- Enjoy the Garden Tram where you can sit back & let the tram guide you throughout the garden.
- View Special Exhibit: Costuming the Crown
- From the blazing gold of Queen Elizabeth’s coronation robe to the simple sophistication of Princess Margaret’s wedding dress, from the mastery of royal cravens and laques to the comfort of clothes worn in private family moments, Costuming THE CROWN will feature 40 iconic costumes from the beloved Emmy award-winning Netflix series, a dramatized history of the reign of Queen Elizabeth II.
- This intriguing exhibition provides a behind-the-scenes look at how costume design is used to create riveting drama and to re-create history. Explore the elegance and style of a costume era by examining the extraordinary contributions of Emmy- and BAFTA-winning designers Michele Clapton and Jane Pettie to Seasons 1 and 2 of The Crown.
