## Director's Corner

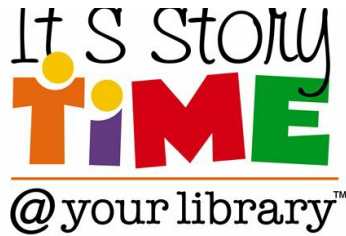
