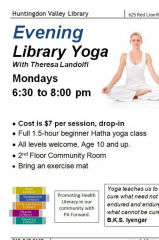

Rating: PG-13 (for thematic elements, disturbing images and brief suggestive material) Runtime: 126 minutes (2 hours - 6 minutes) Movies are free and open to all.
