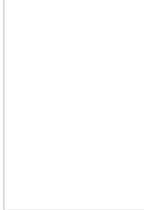

Blitz Tutoring **SAT Prep Courses**

Two 2-day sessions this Fall:
Thursday, October 20 @ 6:30-8:30 pm
& Sunday, October 23 @ 1:00-5:00 pm
Thursday, November 17 @ 6:30-8:30 pm
& Sunday, November 20 @ 1:00-5:00 pm

Registration required. Cost of course is \$100 and includes a binder with prep materials and a practice test.

How is the course run? Before the SAT, students will meet in a small group setting for 2 hours during the week and 4 hours on Sunday. They will take a complete practice test and get a thorough review of each question.

The Guarantee: Students must bring their previous score report from their most recent SAT test. If students complete all the work that is assigned by their instructor in the manner in which it is assigned, we can guarantee a 100-point increase on the SAT (up to 1600 on a 1600-point scale). If students fail to achieve these goals they may repeat the course at no additional cost.
