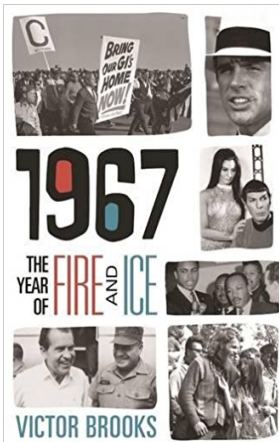
If you are one of our 350 active donors (THANK YOU!), watch the mail for your colorful brochure (complete with pictures of very cute children) and self-addressed envelope.
