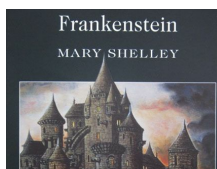
Sunday, October 29

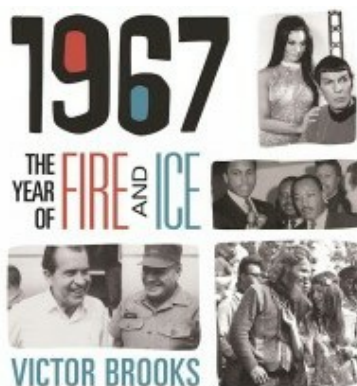
As promised, here are a few details about the Lunch & Learn:
