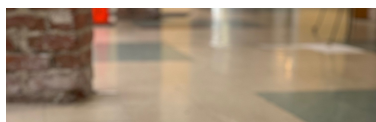

The maple floors upstairs already look better and we are so excited to know the stained and broken tiles in our hallway will be replaced! We're getting a bit of fresh paint, too. Oh and you should see the Valley Youth Center - it's getting a radical transformation.
