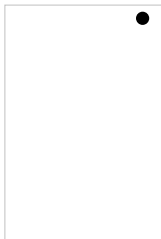
- **Library Yoga** - Wed., Sept. 28 at 10:30 am in Community Room with Theresa Landolfi. \$7 per session, drop in

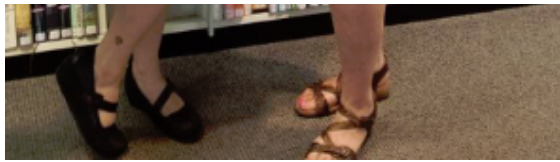
