- **Teen Holiday Reading Challenge**. Teens, celebrate your love of reading this holiday season! The Teen Holiday



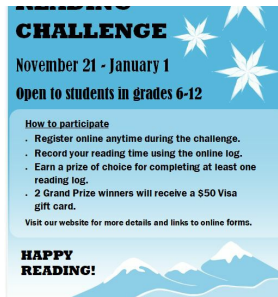
Reading Challenge runs from **November 21 through January 1, 2019**. How does it work?

Form can be filled out anytime during the challenge and only needs to be filled out once.

Then starting on November 21, record your reading time using our [online reading log](#)

form. Record your time as often as you want during the challenge (through January 1.) Submit your hours all at once or every time you read - whatever works best for you!! What counts toward your reading time? EVERYTHING! Fiction, non-fiction, audiobooks, digital books, graphic novels, magazines, assigned reading for school. If you're reading, it counts!! Students 6-12. Prizes - Every student who completes at least one reading log will be able to come into the library and choose either a prize from our prize box or a book from our Teen Book or Choice Cart (one prize of book per person) Students must register in order to be eligible for prizes. There will be 2 Grand Prizes.

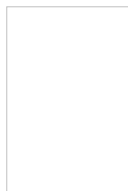


- **Library Yoga** - 10:30 am. Yoga with Theresa Landolfi. \$7 per session, drop-in.

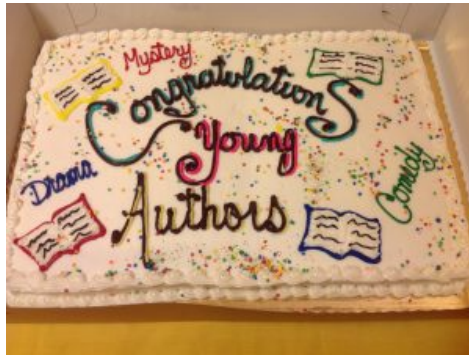

Join us for our first Young Adult Book Club for high schoolers! We will discuss popular mystery novel *One of Us is Lying* by Karen McManus.



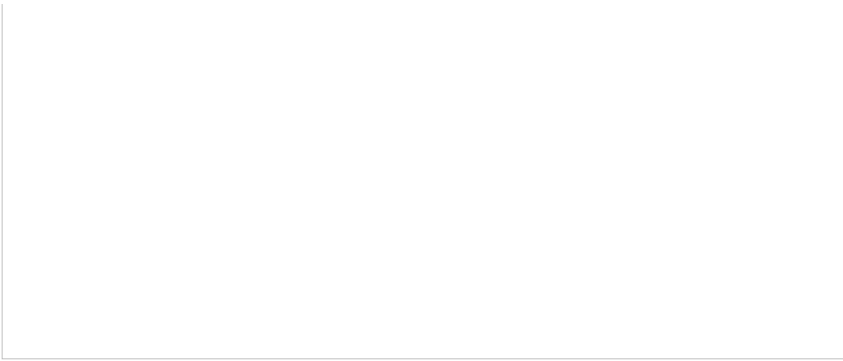

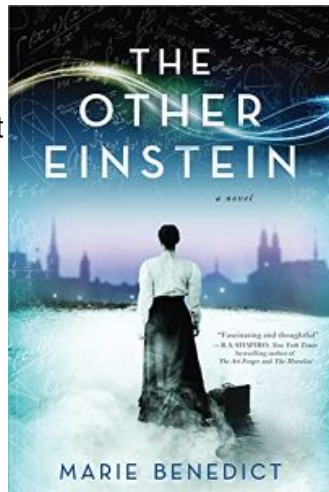
