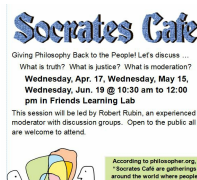

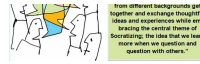

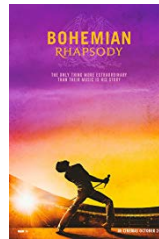
Thursday, April 18
