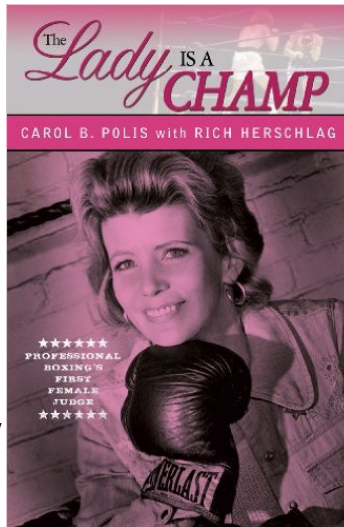

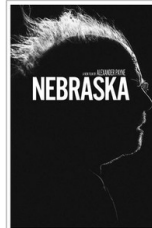

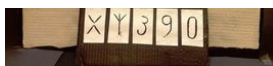

Director's Corner:

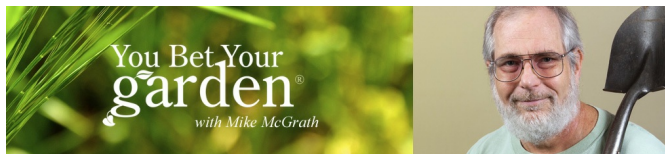
