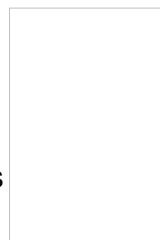
- **Essential Oil uses for Summer** - 7 to 8 pm. We will discover what essential oils are and how several different essential oil products can be used to combat summer pests. Please

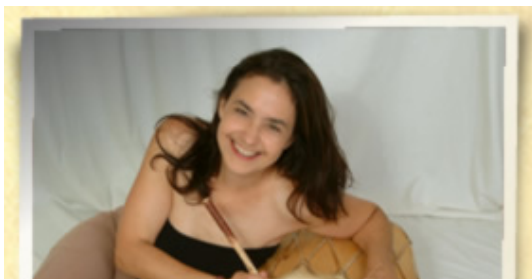
**LIBRARIES ROCK!**

**Adults** are free to attend the Wednesday night Family Programs, but we also have Zumba, computer classes, and a painting workshop just for you!

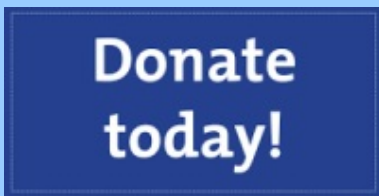

**Friends' Gifts to the Library 2011**

Friends of Huntingdon Valley Library (HVFL) voted funds to purchase books, cards, technology and programs for children and adults. According to Sharon Monahan-Crocker, Library Director, Friends' contributions in 2011 account for 40% of the library budget for materials, 100% for the Quilted Reading Program, and 100% for technology including new public computers and the Quilt and Quilt album needed for our new quilting club. Huntingdon Valley Library volunteers prepare from non-recurring contributions.
