

State Penitentiary and Grounds for Sculpture

Review of the *Museum Pass Policies*:

- Friends with an active 2019 membership may check out passes over the phone. This is a great membership perk!
- Passes circulate for 3 days and the overdue fine is \$5 per day. Plan your trip accordingly - these are VERY popular.
- Passes must be returned at the circulation desk and not put into the drop box, where they can be easily lost or damaged. A fee of \$5 may be charged if the passes are left in the drop box.
- Members may borrow the pass to a given museum three (3) times per year.
