something with music, but would welcome movies and audiobooks. I'm not sure why it's taken me so long to realize that CDs and DVDs will go the way of VHS, soon to be replaced by streaming music and movies. I know we all thought eBooks would make print books obsolete, but we talked about this at our staff meeting and agree that reading is another matter entirely from listening or watching. Personally, I listen to Pandora and watch movies on Netflix or Amazon. I don't even have a way to watch DVDs at home. Am I the new normal? If I could stream movies, TV shows, and new music from the library, would I? Probably - just like I check out the odd eBook from OverDrive while I'm waiting for one of my pre-ordered titles to auto-magically appear on my Kindle. (I'm a bad library patron. I buy most of my books.)

- [Hoopla](#) - a product just for libraries that offers kids movies, music, audiobooks, graphic novels, and eBooks
