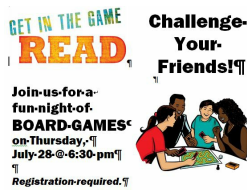

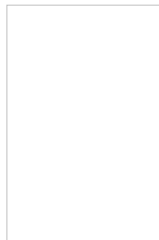

Director's Corner:

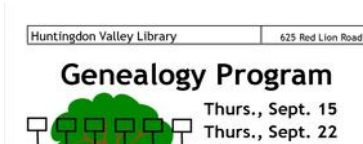
Visit the **Friends' Station** to sign up for the next **New York City Bus Trip**. Details are in the Friends Corner below.
