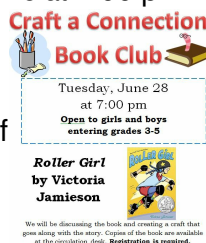

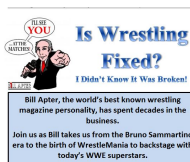

We had 80 kids and parents watch him juggle and unicycle on stage. Want to see for yourself? Watch the video on our [Facebook page!](#)



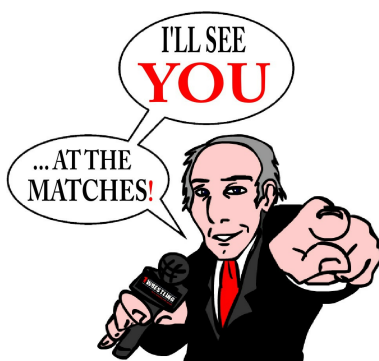
