Director's Corner July 10, 2020

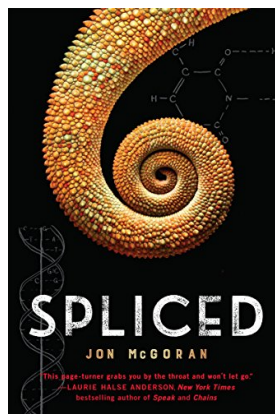
Dear Friends,

Summer fun continues at the library. The Hunt the Grounds scavenger hunt for teens is currently set up around the library property and will be in place for at least one week. The instructions and first clue are posted in the window glass of the back door on the lower level. All clues are outside or can be read from outside. While this activity is intended for teens and is part of their Summer Learning Challenge in Beanstack, I invite everyone to give it a try just for fun! Clues will be checked periodically (especially after today's rain) to make sure nothing is out of place.

We plan to begin allowing patrons into the library to browse, pick up holds, and use three of the public computers on Tuesday, July 21. Times to enter the building will be by appointment via our Events calendar. Masks must be worn while in the library and you must maintain a social distance of 6 feet from staff and other library patrons in compliance with state Health Advisory Mandates.
