Dear Friends,

Indulge me for a moment while I thank everyone for their ongoing support of our library. Reopening has been a careful, well thought-out process, and our community has been patient and kind throughout this pandemic. Contactless Pickup has been very successful, and we are ready for the next step.

We will reopen the building beginning Tuesday, August 4 for two-hour Grab and Go time periods. Days and times are listed in the sidebar. Things will look a bit different when you enter the building. The seating and toys have been removed. However, the staff and books will be there to welcome you back. We have some easy to follow rules.

- Following State mandate, you must wear a mask to enter the building. If you cannot wear a mask, please contact the library, and we will assist you with locating items and setting up a Contactless Pickup time. 215-947-5138
- Please limit your time in the building to 20 minutes. We can only allow 15 people in at a time to allow for social distancing. Say hello, then Grab and Go.
- We will only be using the front door circle entrance. Park in the upper lot.
- Two public computers are available to be reserved for 30-minute sessions. You can reserve them on our Event Calendar or by calling us at 215-947-5138. Computer Assistance is not available at this time.
