Dear Friends,

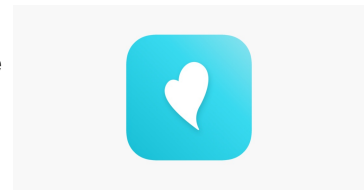
