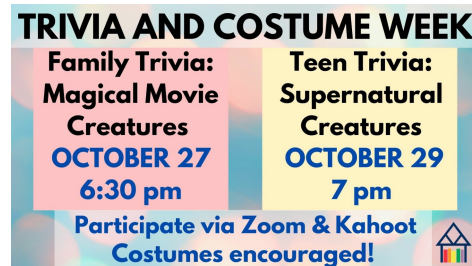

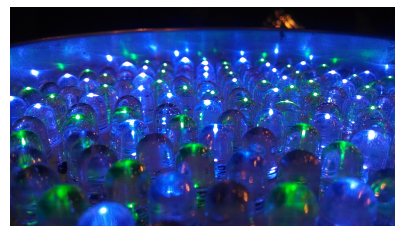
DIY Teens LED Keychain Kit and Virtual Meet-Up


Medicare for 2021


